Layan Nasir is a 21 year old student at university in Palestine. She is a Christian from St. Peter's Church in Birzeit and is described as 'A remarkable young woman with a calm demeanour, tender spirit, and incredible potential.' She was arrested by the Israeli military, handcuffed and blindfolded and taken for interrogation. She was accused of belonging to a progressive student union society. The Israeli authorities declared this group as an 'unlawful association.' Layan was detained in prison until she was released on bail over a month later. She is one of many students who have been imprisoned for similar reasons. It shouldn't be this way. *
